Credit Valley Conservation Authority Breakfast Talk

On Saturday morning at 10AM, Dawn Renfrew, the natural areas inventory project coordinator with the Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) will be our guest speaker. Christine Cushing will host, providing a light breakfast (bring your own coffee mugs), in front of Cabin 23 on Hill 1. Although bats are excellent pest controllers (they can eat three times their body weight in insects every night), they also have a dark side. The CVCA erected bat monitors at Camp the week of July 9th, and Dawn will present the results of their findings. Come and find out more. Dawn has also kindly offered to conduct a small walk-and-talk afterwards for anyone interested in discovering more about Camp's natural habitat, so wear your walking shoes if you would like to participate. Lev Jaeger has offered to conduct a bat house building workshop later in the season, so he will also tell us a little about that project and poll the group's interest.

Bagel Brunch: Philip Berger from Canadian Doctors for Refugee Care came to Camp Naivelt to make a presentation.

Philip has been on the forefront of organizing physicians across English Canada and Quebec who are opposed to the federal government's cuts to refugee health care. His presentation covered the regulations being implemented and the growing movement opposed to the new rules that have drastic impacts against refugees across the country. Three options to voice your opposition to the cuts:

1. Writing to your local MPs, especially those who are conservatives;
2. Writing to the new federal Minister of Health, Chris Alexander who recently has replaced Jason Kenney, and/or;
3. Writing to CIJA [the Centre for Israeli and Jewish Affairs] objecting to their support of the Harper government's restrictions on refugees' access to health care and the declaration that Hungarian refugees are "bogus" claimants. Philip suggested that we write as individuals, and point out that these restrictions will harm Jews seeking refuge from the anti-Semitism now rampant in Hungary.

Saturday Evening Concert with Borealis Recording Artist Eve Goldberg 8PM at the Lasowsky Centre

Eve Goldberg sings music that draws honey from the rock of life. A compelling writer and interpreter, Eve's watercolour voice and solid guitar style has made her a favourite with audiences across Canada and the US.

Her performances are intimate and relaxed, moving effortlessly from folk classics to original gems.

Since 1990, she has performed her trademark mixture of folk, blues, country, bluegrass, old time, and jazz in venues across Canada and the U.S. ranging from small house concerts to the prestigious Kennedy Center in Washington DC. Along the way she's earned the respect of legendary musicians like Peggy Seeger, Geoff Muldaur, and Penny Lang. She has released three CDs to widespread acclaim: "Ever Brightening Day," "Crossing the Water," and her latest, "A Kinder Season." Born in the Boston area, Eve grew up in a progressive secular Jewish household surrounded by folk music. Some of her formative musical experiences came from her summers spent at Camp Kinderland in Massachusetts, a sister camp to Camp Naivelt.
