Work with charcoal and conte to develop black/white renderings. Focus on creating dynamic compositions, volume, light and shadow.

**Day 2 – Saturday**

Develop a full colour painting using paints of your choice. Can also accommodate drawing exercises for anyone who missed Day 1.

**Day 3 – Sunday**

Complete painting and final crit.
